	The role will support the implementation of a range of actions and strategies that enable investigation, design and testing of approaches that embed collaboration and innovation across affected community members y, community service organisations, government and business to reduce and eliminate overrepresentation within Victoria's justice system.

	 Provide high level secretariat support for TARGET ZER0's Leadership Table and sub-committees; Action Groups and Working Groups including scheduling meetings, preparation of meeting documentation and action item follow up; Support TARGET ZER0's PM to deepen TARGET ZER0 coalition members and other key partnerships and grow their commitment to TARGET ZER0; Proactively seek new partnerships that strengthen the reach of TARGET ZER0; Monitor backbone compliance with work plans and provide regular reports and updates to Backbone leads and the Leadership Table; Actively promote TARGET ZER0 including developing internal and external communication content; Lead and participate in networking activities, including sector and professional development activities; Develop and implement a range of content, tools and activities to promote TARGET ZER0 within WJ, other agencies and stakeholders and broader communities; Collect and tabulate data and statistics related to TARGET ZER0 and youth justice overrepresentation; Support the planning and coordination of TARGET ZER0 events (minimum of 2 annually) together with the PM and rest of Backbone; Prepare reports, briefs and papers of behalf of the Backbone Leads for various audiences including but not limited to WJ/CMY, the Leadership Table and funding and other partners.
