An OFFICE WORKER giggles in the background.

ANNA

This is the third time you've made me miss lunch this month!

PETE

Well, learn to work faster and you can come out to lunch too.

PETE and the other OFFICE WORKERS head out to lunch, leaving ANNA to complete the files.

FADE TO

INT. OFFICE: ANNA'S DESK - AFTER LUNCH

PETE and the OFFICE WORKERS have returned from lunch after a couple of beers.

PETE

(telling a story)
And he was like, "Hey, you can't
talk to me like that".

PETE laughs hysterically at his own story as the OFFICE WORKERS return to their desks.

PETE (CONT'D)

(to one of the OFFICE

WORKERS)

Next one's on you, man.

PETE then notices ANNA. He goes over and sits on ANNA's desk, grabs her by the shoulders and starts massaging her.

PETE (CONT'D)

Anna! Sweetheart! Have you been working all this time?

ANNA

(very uncomfortably)

Yes. You told me it was urgent

PETE

Leave it 'til Monday.
